Message from our former President



Dear Friends,

2014 was a milestone year in the 32-year history of Connecticut Food Bank.

In June we broke ground for a new distribution center in Wallingford, CT, and shortly after I announced my decision to retire at the end of the year.

Many of you have been working alongside me in the fight against hunger for many years. When we first started, a few hundred thousand pounds of food were being distributed to 70 food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters annually. With your help, Connecticut Food Bank has grown to distribute more than 20 million pounds of food last year to nearly 700 food-assistance programs throughout Connecticut.

I want you to know that Connecticut Food Bank is positioned well into the future.

Once the new distribution center is open and operational, it will enable Connecticut Food Bank to better serve hungry families. With greater efficiencies, the larger facility and increased refrigerated space, Connecticut Food Bank can accept and distribute more fresh food to people in need, add new programs and enhance current ones, increase partnerships with local growers and food manufacturers, and accommodate more volunteers. The number of meals distributed will double over the next 10 years.

Food banking has been my passion for the last 30 years, and my decision to retire at the end of the year was not an easy one. But you can be assured that my successor, Rob Levine, a very experienced and knowledgeable leader, will ensure the continued success of Connecticut Food Bank's mission as the organization prepares to move into a new distribution center in 2015.

Please know that I am extremely appreciative of the support the citizens of Connecticut have shown over the years in feeding hungry Connecticut families. It has been an honor and a privilege to serve with you in the fight against hunger in Connecticut.

After dedicating 30 years to feeding Connecticut's hungry, Nancy L. Carrington, Connecticut Food Bank's President & CEO, retired at the end of 2014. On behalf of Connecticut Food Bank's Board of Directors, I congratulate Nancy on her remarkable career and outstanding work in meeting the needs of our most vulnerable citizens.

In 1984, Nancy joined Connecticut Food Bank as a food solicitor, working alongside its founder, Mark Patton. By 1989, she was named the organization's Executive Director, and in 2010 its President & CEO. Under Nancy's steadfast leadership, the organization enhanced its outreach and created new programs to better serve families who struggle with hunger. Over the last 25 years, Connecticut Food Bank grew from distributing approximately five million pounds of food to 350 community-based programs, to distributing more than 20 million pounds of food to nearly 700 food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters.

The Board is extremely grateful for Nancy's vision, guidance and efforts to ensure that the Food Bank continues our good work, as we prepare to move into our new operations and distribution center in Wallingford later this year.

It has been a pleasure to work alongside Nancy, and I offer my personal thanks for her dedication and for making a significant difference in the lives of thousands of Connecticut's citizens.

The Faces of Hunger in Connecticut



2014 HUNGER IN AMERICA STUDY

Food or medicine? Food or housing? Purchasing less expensive unhealthy food, or more costly fruits and vegetables?

These are the decisions that thousands in Connecticut are making, according to the Hunger in America 2014 report conducted by Connecticut Food Bank in partnership with Feeding America.

The study reveals that the face of hunger is one we might recognize, as many in our local communities who seek food assistance have jobs, raise families, work toward education and struggle with health problems. Those that turn to our network of food pantries, soup kitchens and shelters are making difficult trade-offs to get enough food for their families.

The report shows that many households served through Connecticut Food Bank's network use the following coping strategies.

63% to 73% choose between paying for food or:

- Utilities
- Transportation
- Medicine
- Housing

73% purchase inexpensive, unhealthy food

54% receive help from friends or family

43% consume food from dented or damaged packages

41% eat food past its expiration date;

41% water down food or drinks

35% pawn or sell personal property

MOBILE PANTRY STORIES

Connecticut Food Bank's Mobile Pantry gives fresh food to people in need, right in their neighborhood.

"IT'S BEEN A BLESSING."

That's how **Cynthia** describes the food assistance she and her family receive each month from Connecticut Food Bank's Mobile Pantry.

Cynthia recently had open-heart surgery and is unable to work. She said the Mobile Pantry helps her, her daughter and two grandchildren through some tough times.

"I've always loved vegetables and sometimes I don't have enough money to buy them," she said.

"When I come here, I always know I can get my fruits and vegetables."

"THE MOBILE PANTRY IS A LIFELINE."

Ernest, a Vietnam War veteran, said the Mobile Pantry is a lifeline. Unable to hold down a job due to a disability from the effects of his service in the war, Ernest said that before he started attending Mobile Pantry distributions, all he would have is a couple of cans of soup, a bag of spaghetti and some milk in the fridge.

Ernest said he now has plenty of healthy food to eat, because the Mobile Pantry brings food to his community.

"I'm able to get vegetables and potatoes, and today I received a variety of peppers and mushrooms. If it wasn't for the Mobile Pantry, I would have less choices and not the variety of food to keep me healthy."



How We Get Our Food



FOOD INDUSTRY PRODUCT DONORS

Connecticut Food Bank is able to distribute more than 20 million pounds of food annually to nearly 700 food-assistance programs through the generosity of food industry partners.

National manufacturers and processors, as well as local retailers are helping to make a difference for the more than 300,000 people we serve through our food-assistance network.

Because eating fresh, nutritious food is often a challenge for many families, Connecticut Food Bank is distributing more organic, natural and healthy food items than ever before. The healthy food items donated by the food industry help remove barriers that prevent people from accessing good nutrition. Among the food items are low-fat yogurt, natural fruit juices, soy milk and gluten-free snacks.

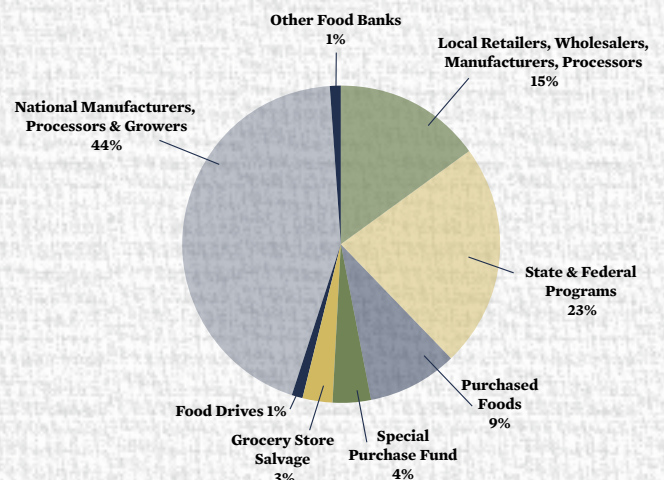

FARM-TO-PANTRY

Since the launch of its Farm-to-Pantry Program in 2011, Connecticut Food Bank has partnered with more than 40 farms to increase the availability of fresh, healthy produce to people in need. One of the ways our Farm-to-Pantry Program has grown is through a successful partnership with the Connecticut Farm Bureau.



“Connecticut farmers have always been good neighbors,” said Henry Talmage, Connecticut Farm Bureau’s Executive Director of Farm Bureau Fight Hunger. “The Farm Bureau’s goal is to broaden the number of farmers who contribute extra produce and other food products to hunger-fighting partners, and to make it easy for farmers to help support these programs with their food donations.”

How Connecticut farms help:

- Donating excess, nearly overripe, blemished, short-coded or misshapen produce.
- Gleaning of fields and orchards, both mid-season and after commercial harvest.
- Dedicating a row to feeding the hungry.

Connecticut Food Bank’s goal is to continue to develop local food channels to feed the hungry, and to support local growers and producers.



COMMUNITY FOOD DONORS AND FOOD DRIVES

Food drives are one of the most personal ways people get directly involved in the fight against hunger. Throughout the year, individuals, groups, schools and institutions collect much-needed food for our neighbors in need, while raising awareness about hunger in their communities. 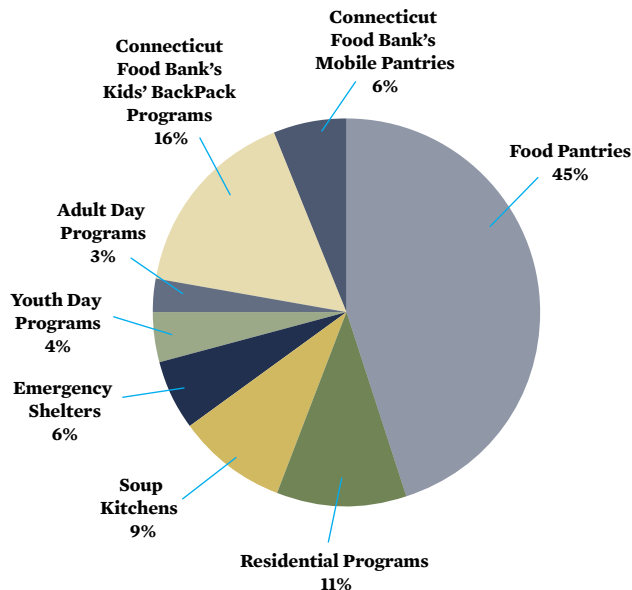

MOBILE PANTRY PROVIDING ACCESS TO HEALTHY, FRESH FOOD

Connecticut Food Bank's Mobile Pantry plays a critical role in getting fresh fruits, vegetables, whole grains and nonfat dairy into the diets of families who often cannot afford to purchase them. Each month, more than 5,000 households can depend on Connecticut Food Bank's Mobile Pantry to arrive at the same time and place, often right in their own neighborhood. Last year, Mobile Pantry distributions totaled 1.6 million pounds of healthy food for families in need.

One young mother of two told us, "The end of the month is really hard for us, so this helps us get through. It is very much appreciated."

The Mobile Pantry Program helps address transportation barriers that make it difficult for low-income individuals and families to access the adequate nutrition they need. KIDS' BACKPACK PROGRAM GIVES CHILDREN ACCESS TO NUTRITIOUS FOOD OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL

There are thousands of children across Connecticut who dread Friday afternoons. The reason? They know that once school is dismissed, there will be little to eat until Monday morning.

Through its Kids' Backpack Program, Connecticut Food Bank provides more than 3,000 children in more than 22 public school districts with bags of nutritious food to take home over the weekend when they do not have access to school meals.

Connecticut Food Bank works with local public school systems, teachers and staff to identify students who are at risk of hunger. According to the 2014 Hunger in America study, 28 percent of our client households have a child under the age of 18. Many of these parents and caregivers are forced to make difficult choices such as paying for food or other expenses for their children.

Quite often these families do not qualify for food stamps (SNAP) and are having difficulty meeting their children's nutritional needs. These underemployed parents lost their "real" jobs and can now only find low-paying work, with many lacking health benefits.

Support for the Kids' Backpack Program enables us to provide hungry children with the proper nourishment that's needed to grow, learn and thrive.

Nonperishable items that are packed include:

- Two shelf-stable milks
- Two entrees, such as beef stew and chicken with rice
- Two whole-grain cereal products
- Two healthy snacks
- Two 100% juice boxes

GROW UP WITH GOOD NUTRITION INITIATIVE

HELPS FAMILIES WITH YOUNG CHILDREN

Thanks to a grant of \$250,000 a year for three years from Stop & Shop's Our Family Foundation, Connecticut Food Bank is helping young families enrolled in early childhood, preschool and daycare programs gain access to healthy food and nutrition education on a regular basis.

Launched in early 2014, the GROW Up with Good Nutrition Initiative features the GROW truck – a brightly colored “food pantry on wheels” that is loaded with healthy food items such as apples, pears, grapefruit, oranges, potatoes, onions, carrots, peanut butter, brown rice, tuna, ground beef, fish, eggs and low-fat milk. Families attend a brief nutrition education workshop before boarding the truck to “shop” for food. They also receive easy-to-prepare recipes for foods that they are unfamiliar with.

The goal of the program is to provide fresh food to families with young children and increase the nutritional content of household meals. One mother whose family is on a tight grocery budget told us she often would purchase less expensive foods that her children were familiar with. After attending a workshop on the importance of eating whole grains, she decided to go home and prepare the brown rice she selected off the GROW truck. Now it's the only rice her children will eat! Another mother called the GROW truck a godsend. She was able to fill her pantry with nutritious food and could make a nice, healthy, warm meal for her family.

It is through valued partnerships with organizations like Stop & Shop that Connecticut Food Bank can fulfill its mission to provide nutritious food to people in need.

“Money is tight and I can give my family good, healthy food more often. I cut and freeze the vegetables and they last until the truck comes again. It's fun for the children and they love to go on the ‘grocery store truck’ to help me pick out the food. It has made them more aware of wanting to eat healthy.”

KEY TO FULFILLING OUR MISSION

Volunteer hours at Connecticut Food Bank reached a staggering 20,000 in 2014, an all-time high, and a 12 percent increase over 2013. More than 4,300 individuals gave time generously to help Connecticut Food Bank meet the needs of thousands who are struggling with hunger.

The boost in volunteers and hours is attributed to the increase in fresh produce that Connecticut Food Bank is distributing throughout six counties. Because produce has a shorter shelf life, extra hands are required to distribute it in a timely manner.

The men, women, teens and children who dedicated their time to helping their neighbors in need assisted us at special events and food drives, sorted and bagged fresh produce, packed bags of nutritious food for our Kids' Backpack Program and distributed healthy food from our GROW Truck and Mobile Pantry.

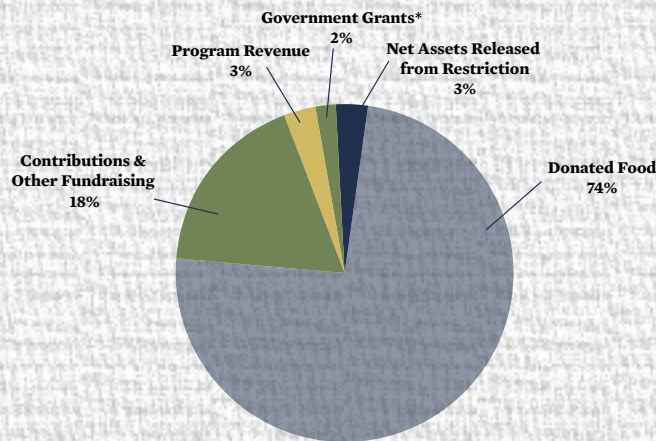

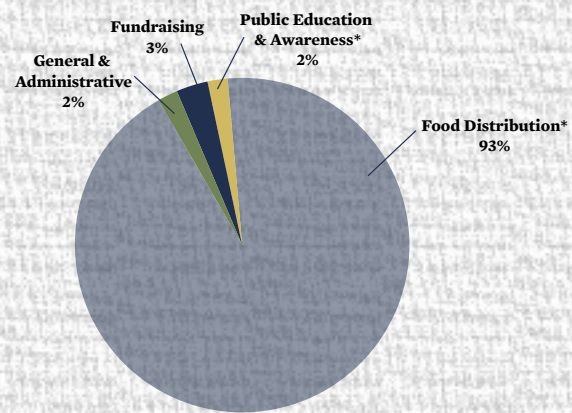
REVENUE & OTHER SUPPORT

Later this year, Connecticut Food Bank will relocate to a new 84,000 square-foot distribution center in Wallingford. This move will position us to grow the amount of nutritious food we distribute across all our communities in the following ways:

- Double the main warehouse square footage
- Increase much-needed cooler space six-fold
- Maximize food donations from the food industry and local grocers
- Expand fresh food initiatives
- Develop new programs and services to reach those especially at risk, including parents with young children, seniors and veterans

The increase in refrigerated space will allow us to significantly expand the availability of fresh produce to our consumers. This building will serve as an important foundation for the Connecticut Food Bank as we continue to evolve to meet the needs of all who call upon us. For example, Connecticut Food Bank is helping to lead the way to develop innovative programs and partnerships among food distributors, healthcare providers, financial partners and insurance experts. By offering a broad range of social services in one location, we are better able to help our neighbors in their hour of need.
